

Non-disclosure agreement

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By submitting Ai XPRT's free trial sign-up form, you [Licensee] are entering into a non-disclosure agreement with Ai XPRT (trading style of Auditxprt Limited, a company registered in England with company number 09916240 whose registered office is at 386Buxton Road, Stockport, England SK2 7BY) and agreeing to the terms and conditions of Ai XPRT's non-disclosure agreement.

The non-disclosure agreement comes into effect on the day of submission of the sign-up form by the Licensee.

Ai XPRT may disclose confidential and proprietary information of AI XPRT ("Proprietary Information") to Licensee, consisting of published and unpublished research or development information, know how, technical data, and business information related to the cyber security and assessment of enterprise vulnerabilities technology. As a result of Licensee's access to the Proprietary Information disclosed by AI XPRT hereunder, Licensee may generate information which shall also be considered Proprietary Information. Licensee shall not disclose Proprietary Information to any third party without the express written consent of AI XPRT, until such Proprietary Information shall become publicly available through no fault or action of Licensee. Licensee shall not use the Proprietary Information for any use other than that expressly authorized herein.

Licensee acknowledges that all material and information which has or will come into the possession and knowledge of each with connection with this agreement of the performance hereof, consists of confidential and proprietary data, whose disclosure to or use by third parties will be damaging. Both parties, therefore, agree to hold such material and information in strictest confidence, not to make use thereof other than for the performance of this agreement, and not to release or disclose it to any other party.

Licensee agrees that it will not, directly or indirectly, disseminate, disclose or otherwise make available to any third party (including any related company), or reverse engineer, any Proprietary Information, as defined below, of the other parties and will use the same degree of care to prevent disclosure thereof that it uses to protect its own proprietary and confidential information, but in any event a degree of care no less than reasonable. Licensee agrees to obligate any Affiliates to abide by this confidentiality obligation. Employees of a party or its Affiliates shall be provided access to Proprietary Information of the other party only on a "need to know" basis and shall be advised of the confidential nature thereof, and shall be bound to protect the confidentiality of such information. The provisions hereof shall survive expiration or termination of this License Agreement for a period of seven (7) years.

Licensee acknowledges that, during the term of this Agreement, it will receive Proprietary Information from the other party. Licensee shall protect the Proprietary Information of the other party with at least the same protection and care that it customarily uses in safeguarding its own confidential information of a similar nature, but shall use no less than a reasonable degree of care and will not use the Propriety Information of the other party for any purpose other than in direct connection with the relationship described under this Agreement. Licensee will disclose the other party's Proprietary Information to its personnel only on a need-to-know basis. Licensee shall take reasonable steps to advise its employees of the confidential nature of the other party's Proprietary Information and their obligation to comply with the confidentiality requirements in this Agreement. Licensee will promptly notify the other if it believes that Proprietary Information has lost its status as such.

Ai XPRT may collect and use Licensee's Data only for the purpose of providing and improving its Product. Ai XPRT will not disclose this any of Licensee's Data in a form that personally identifies Licensee.
